- **Call to Order / Roll Call / Quorum Check** was made by Mayor Al Pallone and the following were in attendance: City Council Members Vince Wiley and Donnie Bagwell; City Manager Kevin McBurnett, City Clerk Robbie Swords, Assistant City Manager Todd Heath, visitors and media.
