- **Call to Order/Roll Call/Quorum Check** was made by Mayor Al Pallone and the following were in attendance: City Council Members Brush and Bagwell; City Manager Kevin McBurnett, City Clerk Robbie Swords, media and visitor.
- **Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance** was led by Bagwell.
- **Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting** – A motion was made by Brush to approve the minutes as presented with a second from Bagwell. Motion Carried.
- **Public Forum/Citizen's Comment**
- **HEARINGS:**
  - 1. **Hearing – Ordinance FY2020 Budget** – Mayor Pallone opened the hearing, no comments were made and hearing was closed.
- **OLD BUSINESS:**
  - 1. **Ordinance – FY2020 Budget** – Bagwell made a motion to approve with a second from Brush. Motion Carried.
- **NEW BUSINESS:**
  - 1. **Top Shelf Concessions – Amend Hours of Operation** – Tony Black requested his hours of serving alcohol be extended from 7:00 pm to a later time. A motion was made by Bagwell to extend hours maintaining the other stipulations as: Hours to serve alcohol would be from 12:30 pm until 9:30 pm, a 3 drink maximum, and an officer must be duty. A second was given by Brush. Motion Carried.
  - 2. **Resolution – Brunch Bill Referendum** – McBurnett reviewed the question to permitting Sunday sales of distilled spirits or alcoholic beverages by the drink beginning at 11:00 am. He stated this resolution would authorize this question to be put on a referendum for the November election. A motion was made by Bagwell with a second from Brush. Motion Carried.
