- O HEARINGS:
 - 1. **Hearing Ordinance FY2020 Budget –** Mayor Pallone opened the hearing, no comments were made and hearing was closed.
- OLD BUSINESS:
 - 1. **Ordinance FY2020 Budget** Bagwell made a motion to approve with a second from Brush. Motion Carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. **Top Shelf Concessions Amend Hours of Operation –** Tony Black requested his hours of serving alcohol be extended from 7:00 pm to a later time. A motion was made by Bagwell to extend hours maintaining the other stipulations as: Hours to serve alcohol would be from 12:30 pm until 9:30 pm, a 3 drink maximum, and an officer must be duty. A second was given by Brush. Motion Carried.
- 2. Resolution Brunch Bill Referendum McBurnett reviewed the question to permitting Sunday sales of distilled spirits or alcoholic beverages by the drink beginning at 11:00 am. He stated this resolution would authorize this question to be put on a referendum for the November election. A motion was made by Bagwell with a second from Brush. Motion Carried.
